The FADE Institute RDAEF₂ Program Tuition and Payment Plan Options

Students enrolling in the FADE Institute RDAEF Program are provided options for tuition payments with flexible plans and non-interest-bearing terms. For students who need extended terms beyond the three options we provide, we suggest looking for a loan company or shop around for a zero % interest credit card whereby a portion of your tuition could be deferred from high monthly payments if a no-interest bearing card is used for some or all of your tuition balance. We do not accept federal funding, state funding programs or taxpayer educational grants in order to ensure that our programs and courses remain of the highest caliber possible while maintaining reasonable tuition rates.

The table below shows the current tuition rate based on which EF program pathway you are qualified to attend. If you are currently a Registered Dental Assistant, your required program hours total 410; if you are currently an original RDAEF, licensed prior to 2010, your program is 318 hours.

<i>Additional Program Fees (non-tuition-based costs not included in payment plan)</i>			
1. Magnification Loupes – Designs for Vision = price determined at fitting (approximately \$2,150) Direct student purchase from Designs for Vision (six-month payment plans available without interest)			
2. Instrument/Materials Kit = purchased directly from FADE Institute; at least 50% due at time of enrollment; may be split into two payments = \$1,900			
3. Typodont Kit = homework/lab typodont, benchmount, repair items and teeth – purchased during second month of program = \$850 (fee approximate based on current equipment rate)			
4. State Board examination/application fees = \$620 (anticipated fee change by 1/1/2022)			
5. SDDS/SDDF/ADAA Student Membership and Professional Insurance; not optional; FADE to provide grant for first year ADAA membership and insurance premium when student pays for SDDS/SDDF membership = \$170 renewable each year			
6. Scrub pants and top with black warm-up jacket; black or white close-toes shoes or tennis shoes			
7. Possess or have access to a quality color printer for homework assignment printing and collecting of chapters for Compendium – a Study Guide for the RDAEF Written State Board examination
